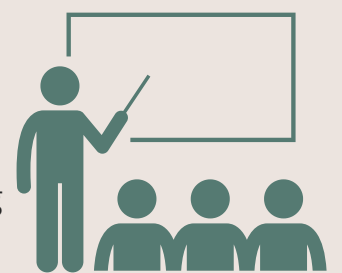


What other activities, hobbies, or experiences helped to prepare you for a job in your industry?
