

The CEE “one CS course” rule states that CEE students may take no more than ONE CS course per academic year, regardless of whether the course counts toward the CEE degree requirements. Note that an academic year is defined as one fall and one spring semester. Students should discuss with their advisor, alternative non-CS courses that may cover the same content.

Petition will not be considered if student elected a “pass/fail” or “audit” grade option or earned a letter grade of “C” or lower in previously completed CS course.
