CONNECTING

Wired

1. Connect the **HDMI cable** to your laptop.
2. Tap **Laptop** on the panel.
3. Connect the **USB cable** to use the conference camera and microphone.

Wireless

1. Tap **Wireless Presentation** on the panel.
2. Follow the steps on the screen to connect your device.
3. Tap **End Presentation** to disconnect.

DISPLAY ONE DEVICE

1. Tap the touch panel.
2. Under **Devices**, tap the device that you want to display.

USE HYBRID TEACHING TECHNOLOGY

1. Connect the **USB cable** to your laptop to use the conference camera and microphone.
2. Start a **Zoom** meeting on your computer.
3. Use the **Zoom app** to:
 - change the audio and video settings for the conference camera and microphone.
 - share your screen.
