Behavioral Economics: In progress or completion of 36-200 (or equivalent), 73-102, 88-120, and either 88-360 (if it is a fall semester) or 88-367 (if it is a spring semester) with a C or better.

Cognitive Neuroscience: Completion of 03-121 and 85-219 with a C or better.
Cognitive Science: Completion of 85-211 and 15-112 with a C or better.
Creative Writing: Completion of one of the introductory genre writing courses (76-260, 76-261, 76-262, 76-265, 76-269) with a B or better.

Cybersecurity \& International Conflict: Completion of one of the following courses: 84-275, 84-326, 84-387, 84-388, or 84405 with a C or better.

Decision Science: Completion of 88-120 with a C or better. In progress or completion of 36-200 (or equivalent), 85-102, and 73102 with a C or better.

Economics: Completion of 73-102 or 73-103, and either 21-120 (or 21-112) or 36-200 with a C or better.
Environmental \& Sustainability Studies: In progress or completion of 24-291/09-291 and one of the Electives courses offered by Dietrich College, including: Grand Challenge Interdisciplinary First-Year Seminars, Economics, English, History, Philosophy, Modern Languages, IPS or SDS with a C or better. One of these courses must be completed and the other may be in progress.

Ethics, History, \& Public Policy: In progress or completion of at least one History Core course and one Philosophy Core course with a C or better. One of these courses must be completed and the other may be in progress.

Film \& Visual Media Studies: Completion of 76-239 with a B or better.
Global Studies: In progress or completion of 79-201 or 79-275 with a C or better.
Global Systems \& Management: Completion of two courses from the curriculum with a C or better.
Humanities Analytics: Completion of 76-275 with a B or better.
Information Systems: In progress or completion of 15-112 with a B or better. BHA applicants not currently in IS must additionally apply to IS to be considered for admission, which is due on the last day of classes. BHA IS admission decisions are held until the end of the semester for IS application review.

International Relations \& Political Science: Completion of 84-104 or 84-275 with a C or better.
Linguistics: Completion of 80-180 with C or better.
Literature \& Culture: Completion of one of the following courses: 76-203, 76-217, 76-230, 76-233, 76-245, or 76-247 with a B or better.

Logic \& Computation: Completion of 15-112, and either 21-127 or 80-211 with a C or better.
Modern Languages: Completion of two courses in selected language at the intermediate level with a C or better.
Philosophy: Completion of at least one 80-xxx course with a C or better.
Policy \& Management: In progress or completion of 36-200 (or equivalent), 73-102, and either 88-150 (if it is a fall semester) or $88-255$ (if it is a spring semester) with a C or better.

Politics \& Public Policy: Completion of 84-104 with a C or better.
Professional Writing: Completion of 76-271 with a B or better.
Psychology: Completion of any 85-1xx or 85-2xx course with a C or better.
Social \& Political History: In progress or completion of two History courses (79-xxx, any level) with a C or better.
Statistics: Completion of the following courses with a C or better: a Statistics course (36-200 or 202 preferred), a multivariate or matrix algebra course ( $21-256,259,240,241$, or 242 ), a probability course (36-235 or 225 ), and a programming course (15-110 or 112).

Statistics \& Machine Learning: Completion of the following courses with a C or better: a Statistics course (36-200 or 202 preferred), a multivariate or matrix algebra course (21-256, 259, 240, 241, or 242), a probability course (36-235 or 225), and 15-112.

Technical Writing: Completion of 76-271 with a B or better.
