Description

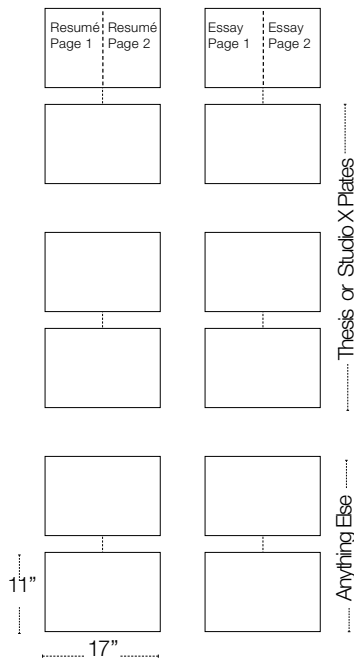

The emphasis on professional promise, as it may be measured in both attitudes and scholastic attainment, serves as a balance to the AIA Medal Award, which is given only on the basis of scholarship. The amount of this award is **\$9,000**.

Submission & Selection

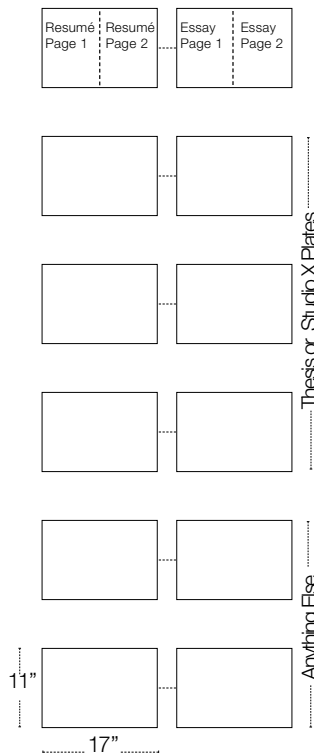
This submission is in lieu of studio documentation. Following one of the submission options below, create a 12-page, 11x17" PDF file of your work. **Submissions are judged anonymously; your name should not appear anywhere on your plates.** Upload this as a twelve-page PDF to the Architecture Server in the **Brown Award** (\archpcserver/Brown Award) folder by **10PM on 10 May**. File names are as follows: **slbrown_lastname.PDF**. The School of Architecture will **print and display** all award applications in CFA 214. Three members of the American Institute of Architects Pittsburgh Chapter Board of Directors will constitute the jury that recommends the winner. Folios will be returned **upon request** after the graduation ceremony on 14 May 2011.

- Double-page spread resume on one (1) 11 x 17" plate listing your achievements, education, awards, internships and jobs.
- Double-page spread essay on one (1) 11 x 17" plate describing your scholastic achievements, career plans and planned use of the funds to further your career objectives.
- Six (6) plates documenting your Thesis or Studio X Project.
- Four (4) plates, which may include the following
 - Studio Work
 - Studio Documentation
 - Study Abroad Work
 - Non-Major Studies
 - Extra-Curricular Work
 - Anything else!
