Carnegie Mellon (5-0) vs. #12 Rochester (5-1)

Series: Rochester leads the all-time series 26-11 and holds a 15-3 edge in Rochester. The Tartans last defeated the Yellowjackets in Rochester during the 1995-1996 season. Rochester has won 15 of the last 16 meetings and prior to the Tartans home win last season, won 14 straight.

Last Meeting: Rochester defeated Carnegie Mellon 62-57 at the Louis Alexander Palestra in Rochester February 26, 2005. With the win, Rochester clinched the University Athletic Association (UAA) championship and its fourth straight bid to the NCAA Division III playoffs.

Carnegie Mellon Last Time Out: The Tartans defeated La Roche College 95-79 Tuesday, November 29 to improve to 5-0. The Tartans shot 62.5% from the floor in the win and dominated the glass pulling in 38 rebounds to LaRoche's 20.

Senior forward Marques Johnson broke an 8-8 tie with a lay up at the 13:51 mark in the first half and Carnegie Mellon led the rest of the night. The Tartans would extend their lead to 42-34 at the half. LaRoche would cut the Tartan lead to four points six minutes into the second half after converting on back-to-back offensive fouls from the Tartans. Carnegie Mellon would regain their composure and build back their lead. The Tartans would lead by as many as 17 in the second half to cruise to the victory.

Johnson shot 6-6 from the floor cashing in a career-high 17 points. Senior Clayton Barlow-Wilcox led all scorers with a career-high 30 points, shooting 12-15 from the floor. Barlow-Wilcox dished out seven assists and grabbed six rebounds. Senior Nate Maurer was the only other Tartan in double figures, as he added 14.

Rochester Last Time Out: Rochester defeated St. Lawrence College 58-49 Wednesday, November 30 to improve to 5-1. Uche Ndubizu (16) and Jon Onyiriuka (11) combined for 27 points for Rochester as they shot a combined 9-16 from the floor.

The first half was marked by 11 lead changes and three ties. The Yellowjackets took the lead for good (30-27) on a three-point play by Ndubizu at the 18:02 mark in the second half. St. Lawrence would pull within one (38-37) half-way through the half, but would not have enough as Rochester would go on for the nine-point victory.

Making History:

Carnegie Mellon's 5-0 start marks the best start in school history. The Tartans started the 2003-2004 season 4-0 before dropping a 90-60 decision to Division I Robert Morris.

Wingen Takes Step Closer:

Carnegie Mellon's Head Coach Tony Wingen needs 11 wins to become the All-Time winningest coach in school history. Wingen currently has 163 wins.

Three Digit Scores:

The Tartans scored 100 points in a 106-70 victory over Oberlin College in the first day of the Radisson / Carnegie Mellon Tournament. The Tartans scored 100 points last season in the tournament falling 102-100 to Westminster in the championship game. Prior to last season, Carnegie Mellon had not scored 100 or more points in a game since 1996 when they defeated Thiel College 110-96.

Climbing the Charts:

Senior **A.J. Straub** is in second place on Carnegie Mellon's career three-point field goals made with 142 for his career.

1,000 Club:

Senior **Clayton Barlow-Wilcox** has 878 career points. He needs 122 to become the 16th Tartan to reach 1,000 points for their career.

UAA Rankings:

The Tartans are ranked first in the UAA in scoring offense (92.8 ppg.), 3-point field goal percentage (.410), assists per game (20.8) and blocks per game (5.0). **Barlow-Wilcox** is ranked first in rebounding (10.2 rpg.), junior **Greg Gonzalez** is ranked first in field goal % (80.0) and sophomore **Geoff Kozak** ranks first in steals (2.4 spg.).

Staying Perfect:

The Tartans have won 12 straight non-conference regular season contests.
