### The Series:

Carnegie Mellon University (6-4) will meet Gettysburg College (6-4) for the first time.

### Lackner Versus Streeter:

Carnegie Mellon's Head Coach Rich Lackner has posted a 155-64-2 career record in 21 years at the helm of the Tartans. Gettysburg Head Coach Barry Streeter has a 147-137-5 overall record in his 29th year at the helm.

### Hitting 150:

With the 33-10 victory at Rochester on September 1, Head Coach Rich Lackner became the 27th head coach in Division III with 150 career wins.

### Gimson Honored by UAA:

Halfback Robert Gimson was honored as UAA Offensive Athlete of the Week following his performance in the Tartans 39-21 win over Washington & Lee University on Saturday.

### Mistake Free is the Key:

The Tartans have a plus six turnover margin. In their four losses they have turned the ball over 14 times compared to five times in their six wins.

### Points Do Not Show Everything:

The Tartans have outscored their opponents 243-161 and have outscored them in every quarter this season besides overtime.

### Holding onto a Lead:

The Tartans have a record of 6-1 when leading after three quarters of play. Their lone loss was a 20-17 overtime defeat to Case Western Reserve.

### Staying Perfect:

The Tartans have a record of 4-0 when holding their opponents to under 100 yards rushing and a 5-0 mark when holding them to under 300 yards of total offense.

### National Rankings:

Defensive back Jon Scholl is averaging 11.9 tackles per game ranking him 25th in Division III. Fullback Travis Sivek ranks 23rd with a scoring average of 9.6 points per game. The offense ranks 10th in rushing with 283.8 yards per game as the defense ranks 33rd in scoring defense allowing 16.1 points per contest.

### Gimson Climbs the Charts:

Senior halfback Robert Gimson rushed for 161 yards last week moving him into third place on the school's all-time rushing list passing Scott Barnyak (1987-90). Gimson now has 2,643 yards for his career.

### Back-to-Back 1,000:

In the Tartans 39-21 win over Washington & Lee senior running backs Travis Sivek and Robert Gimson surpassed the 1,000 yard barrier for the second consecutive season. They both finished the game over 100 yards for the fifth time this season and ninth time for their careers. Sivek also reached the 4,000 yard mark for his career now having 4,101 career rushing yards.

### Sivek Scores Again:

Fullback Travis Sivek scored the 59th touchdown of his career last week giving him at least one TD in every game this season. He is the all-time leader in rushing touchdowns in the history of the program and ranks currently ranks 18th on the NCAA Division III scoring list with 354 points for his career. He needs four points to move into 17th, six for 16th and eight for 15th.

### Red-Zone:

The Tartans have made 37 trips into the red-zone this season capitalizing on 31 (83.8%) of them, scoring 26 touchdowns.

### The Big D:

The Tartans defense recorded seven sacks for a loss of 56 yards against Grove City. The school record for sacks in a single game is eight, occurring October 30, 1993 against Grove City. Seven sacks in a single game have been recorded two other times; September 26, 1998 against Alfred and October 17, 1998 against Chicago.

### The Streak:

Carnegie Mellon extended it to 33 consecutive seasons of playing .500 or better with their victory over Bethany College November 3. During the stretch they have a combined record of 237-82-4.

### Undefeated in 2006:

Last year marked the sixth time the Tartans finished the regular season with an unblemished mark. It also happened in 1978, 1979, 1983, 1985, and 1990.
