Tartan Head Coach: Tony Wingen (Springfield, '82) is in his 22nd season as the head coach at Carnegie Mellon University with an overall record of 248-297 at the helm. Prior to coaching the Tartans, Wingen had a two-year stint as the head coach at the University of the South, where he compiled a 21-28 record. Carnegie Mellon's 79-72 victory over Washington University, Feb. 3, 2006 made Wingen the all-time winningest coach in school history. Wingen recorded his 200th career victory November 17, 2006 in the Tartans 77-66 victory over Washington & Jefferson and his 200th victory at the helm of the Tartans January 13, 2008 defeating Lycoming 81-59.

Carnegie Mellon (7-13, 2-7) at Chicago (11-9, 4-5) and Washington (15-5, 7-2)

The Series: Chicago leads the all-time series 33-15. Earlier this season, the Maroons defeated Carnegie Mellon 100-55 in Pittsburgh. The Tartans have only won twice in the Windy City.

Washington leads the all-time series 40-8. Earlier this season, the Bears defeated Carnegie Mellon 66-64 in Pittsburgh. The Tartans have won three times in St. Louis.

Midwest Travel:

In 2004-05, Carnegie Mellon became the second UAA team and the first since Rochester (91-92) to sweep the Washington/Chicago road trip defeating Washington 99-93 and Chicago 75-73. In 2009-10, Brandeis became the third team to accomplish the sweep. Last season, Emory became the fourth while also the fifth this season.

Leading at the Half:

The Tartans are 3-2 when leading after the first 20 minutes of play. They have lost 20 games in the past eight seasons after leading at the break while winning 72.

Under 65:

Carnegie Mellon is 4-1 when holding its opponents under 65 points.

Over 65:

All seven wins this season for the Tartans have come when they scored at least 65 points.

From Way Downtown:

Carnegie Mellon has made at least one three-point basket in 286 straight contests. The last game the Tartans went without a triple was in a 63-49 setback at Rochester Jan. 19, 2001.

50 or Better:

Carnegie Mellon is 4-0 when shooting better than 50% from the floor. Over the past 10 years they are 35-4 and have won their last 15 regular season contests when doing so.

Overtime:

Carnegie Mellon has played three overtime games this season and has a record of 1-2. This is the most overtime games played in a season since 2001-02 with they played four and were 2-2.

Tartans vs. Ranked Opponents:

Carnegie Mellon is 1-2 against Top 25 opponents this season.

UAA Success

The UAA had early season success in nonconference play, sporting a 64-23 overall record (.736).

On the Glass:

The Tartans are 3-2 when holding the edge on the glass.

Triple Digit Scoring:

Since the 1947-48 season, the Tartans are 18-1 when scoring 100 or more points in a contest. The lone loss was November 28, 2004 to Westminster College, 102-100. Since then Carnegie Mellon has won five straight.

Century Mark:

The Tartans broke the 100-point mark in a 112-106 double overtime victory at King's College December 10, marking the third most points scored in program history. In 2006, the Tartans topped Penn State Fayette 121-51 recording the most points. Prior to 2006 the most points scored were 119 during the 1959-60 season, as then Carnegie Tech defeated Slippery Rock 119-116.

Record Book Watch:

John Duhring currently is tied for 11th on the school's all-time three-pointers made list with 101. He needs four more to move into 10th.

Charity Stripe Success:

The Tartans shot 87.5% (14-16) from the foul line in a 66-64 setback to Washington January 15. The last time Carnegie Mellon shot better from the stripe was 37 games prior when they were 9-10 for 90% against Case Western Reserve in 2010.

UAA Rankings:

The Tartans rank first in 3-pt field goal % defended (.333), second in blocks (4.8 bpg) and fourth in steals (7.1 spg). **Joe Kromka** ranks second in blocks (1.8 bpg) and 10th in rebounding (5.8 rpg). **John Duhring** ranks seventh in free throw % (.800). **Asad Meghani** ranks seventh in 3-pt field goals made per game (2.1) and in 3-pt field goal % (.467). **Matt Loebbaka** ranks ninth in blocks (0.7 bpg). **Rashaun Riley** ranks ninth in 3-pt field goal % (.444).
