**Tartan Head Coach: Tony Wingen (Springfield, '82)** is in his 22nd season as the head coach at Carnegie Mellon University with an overall record of 247-292 at the helm. Prior to coaching the Tartans, Wingen had a two-year stint as the head coach at the University of the South, where he compiled a 21-28 record. Carnegie Mellon's 79-72 victory over Washington University, Feb. 3, 2006 made Wingen the all-time winningest coach in school history. Wingen recorded his 200th career victory November 17, 2006 in the Tartans 77-66 victory over Washington & Jefferson and his 200th victory at the helm of the Tartans January 13, 2008 defeating Lycoming 81-59.

# Carnegie Mellon TARTANS

## Carnegie Mellon (6-8, 1-2) vs. #8 Emory (13-1, 2-1) and Rochester (9-5, 0-3)

**The Series:** Emory leads the series over Carnegie Mellon 26-20. Last season, the team's split with each winning on its home court.

Rochester leads the all-time series 33-16 and holds a 19-5 edge in Rochester. The Yellowjackets have won 23 of the last 28 meetings and eight of the last 11.

#### Leading at the Half:

The Tartans are 2-1 when leading after the first 20 minutes of play. They have lost 19 games in the past eight seasons after leading at the break while winning 71.

#### Under 65:

Carnegie Mellon is 4-1 when holding its opponents under 65 points.

#### Over 65:

Carnegie Mellon is 6-3 when scoring at least 65 points.

#### From Way Downtown:

Carnegie Mellon has made at least one three-point basket in 280 straight contests. The last game the Tartans went without a triple was in a 63-49 setback at Rochester Jan. 19, 2001.

#### 50 or Better:

Carnegie Mellon is 3-0 when shooting better than 50% from the floor. Over the past 10 years they are 34-4 and have won their last 14 regular season contests when doing so.

#### On the Glass:

The Tartans are 3-1 when holding the edge on the glass.

#### Triple Digit Scoring:

Since the 1947-48 season, the Tartans are 18-1 when scoring 100 or more points in a contest. The lone loss was November 28, 2004 to Westminster College, 102-100. Since then Carnegie Mellon has won five straight.

#### Century Mark:

The Tartans broke the 100-point mark in a 112-106 double overtime victory at King's College December 10, marking the third most points scored in program history. In 2006, the Tartans topped Penn State Fayette 121-51 recording the most points. Prior to 2006 the most points scored were 119 during the 1959-60 season, as then Carnegie Tech defeated Slippery Rock 119-116.

#### UAA Success

The UAA had early season success in nonconference play, sporting a 64-23 overall record (.736).

**John Duhring** currently ranks 12th on the school's all-time three-pointers made list with 91. He needs 11 more to move into 11th.

#### Charity Strip Success:

The Tartans shot 87.5% (14-16) from the foul line in a 66-64 setback to Washington January 15. The last time Carnegie Mellon shot better from the stripe was 37 games prior when they were 9-10 for 90% against Case Western Reserve in 2010.

#### Double Figures:

**Rashaun Riley** has scored in double figures in nine of 14 games this season including recording a career-high 24 points against Bethany. The sophomore averaged 6.0 points as a freshman and appeared in all 24 games. **Christian Manoli** and **Joe Kromka** have recorded eight double figure games.

#### UAA Rankings:

The Tartans rank second in the UAA in blocks (4.7 bpg) and third in steals (7.1 spg) and 3-pt field goal % defended (.307). **Joe Kromka** ranks third in blocks (1.8 bpg) and 10th in rebounding (5.6 rpg). **John Duhring** ranks sixth in free throw % (.789). **Asad Meghani** ranks sixth in 3-pt field goal % (.480) and 3-pt field goals made per game (2.2). **Matt Loebbaka** ranks seventh in blocks (0.9 bpg). **Rashaun Riley** ranks 10th in 3-pt field goal % (.455).
