

Requirements for obtaining extra-credit by writing a summary of a Computational Biology seminar

You may obtain 5 extra credit points by attending a computational biology seminar at Carnegie Mellon or the University of Pittsburgh, and submitting a written summary of it. You may submit up to ten summaries over the course.

The summary should contain:

- Date, time, title of seminar and name of presenter
- Description of biological problem being addressed
- Description of algorithm used
- Description of evaluation criteria used to judge success
- Summary of results: application of evaluation criteria

The summary should be created as a Word document or plain text and emailed to murphy@cmu.edu no later than one week after the seminar.
