PUBLICATION AWARD APPLICATION

Eligibility:

Any undergraduate who completes a body of scientific research judged by his or her faculty advisor to be of sufficient quality as to be publishable in a refereed journal (either by itself or in conjunction with work completed by others) is eligible for nomination. The student must be currently enrolled at the time of nomination, and in good academic standing. While nominees must be enrolled at the time of nomination, they remain eligible for the award after graduation.

Awards:

An unrestricted award of \$500.00 will be granted to the student upon acceptance by a refereed journal of a paper of which he or she is the author, providing that the faculty advisor certifies that the student contributed significantly to the writing of the paper.

Nominations:

A letter of nomination from the faculty advisor should be submitted along with a draft title, author list and abstract for the paper. The nomination letter must clearly indicate the relative contributions of the student and any coauthors. Nominations should be submitted to Dr. Elizabeth Jones, 200A Mellon Institute.
