Leveraging Investments in Creativity (LINC)

Leveraging Investments in Creativity is a 10-year initiative to improve artists' ability to make work, build social capital and contribute to democratic values. LINC builds on recent research by the Urban Institute that identifies programs and services for artists but points to the need for new efforts that expand financial supports for artists' work; improve artists' access to essential material supports such as live-work space and insurance and bolster knowledge, collaborations, and public policies that affect the work of artists and their contributions to communities.
