Directions to Allegheny County Locations

Carnegie Mellon University, Oakland

(412) 651-4452 (cell phone: use for emergencies)

Class will meet from 9 to noon or 9 to 4 (see your acceptance letter). Please arrive by 8:45 and allow time for walking your child from your car to the classroom. Pick up will be at 12:15 or 4:15.

To get to CMU, go on Forbes Avenue heading away from the University of Pittsburgh toward Squirrel Hill. The CMU campus will be on the right side, just past the Carnegie Library and the light at Craig Street. If you're using MapQuest, use 5000 Forbes as our address. See below for specific directions to your class. Staff members wearing C-MITES t-shirts will be standing outside waiting to greet you. For all of these drop off locations, you must stay in your car. If you need to park and walk in with your child, park in the university parking garage on Forbes Ave. and walk to the drop-off location. If you arrive very early, please drive around the block and come back. Campus Police has asked us not to block these streets with waiting cars.

Harry Potter's Science Adventure, Alice for Beginning Programmers, Bridge Boom, Roaming Ancient Rome, K'NEX Geometry, and How Things Work: Go up Forbes Ave. past the university. Make a right on Margaret Morrison St., a left on Tech St., and a right on Frew St. The drop-off location will be on your right, near the end of Frew St. before the intersection with Roberts Drive.

Amusement Park Physics and Math Counts & More: Go up Forbes Ave., past the intersection with Morewood Ave. You will see the Carnegie Mellon parking garage on the right. In front of the garage there is a traffic turnaround where you can pull in to drop off your child.

Robotics: Meet in front of Hamburg Hall. This is the first Carnegie Mellon building you will see on your right as you come up Forbes Ave., just after the bridge. Pull into the circular driveway in front of Hamburg Hall.

Green Engineering, Solar System Astronomy, and Programming Using Alice: Go up Forbes Ave., make a right on Margaret Morrison St., a left on Tech St., and a right on Frew. The drop-off location is 100 feet further on your right, behind Hunt Library.

Campus School of Carlow University, Pittsburgh

(412) 578-6158

From downtown Pittsburgh take the Forbes Avenue exit from the parkway. Turn left onto Halkett Street, travel one block and turn left onto Fifth Avenue. Turn right up the Carlow University driveway. At the top of the hill stay to the right and drop off at the entrance to the Children's School. (3333 Fifth Avenue)

Ellis School, Oakland (412) 661-5992

Take the Parkway (I-376) to the Oakland exit. Follow Forbes Avenue past the University of Pittsburgh and CMU. Turn left on Morewood Avenue and turn right on Fifth Avenue. Proceed on Fifth to Shady Avenue. Stay in the left lane. Just past the intersection of Shady and Fifth, Ellis is located on the left side of Fifth Avenue. (6425 Fifth Avenue)

Grace Baptist Church of Western PA, Monroeville (412) 372-8466

Take the Parkway East to Exit 84A (48-South Monroeville). Go across Route 22. At the second light, turn left onto Northern Pike. The church is located 1.1 mile down the road on the right side. (4518 Northern Pike)

Highlands High School, Natrona Heights (724) 226-1000

Travel Route 28 North to Exit 14 (Tarentum, New Kensington). Turn right off the exit ramp. Get into the far left lane at the first traffic light and turn left onto Freeport Road. At the fourth light, make a right onto Montana Avenue. Continue 4 blocks and make a right onto Pacific Avenue. The school is on the left. (1500 Pacific Avenue)

Seton-La Salle Catholic High School, Dormont (412) 561-3583

From the intersection of West Liberty Ave. and Pioneer (near the Saturn dealer), turn onto Pioneer Ave. Make a right at the stop sign onto McNeilly Rd. Go through one light. You will see the sign for the school on your left. DO NOT ENTER the first driveway. Go past the school and go up the second driveway. (1000 McNeilly Road)

St Alexis Catholic School, Wexford (724) 935 3940

Take US-19 N/McKnight Road to Pine Creek Road. Turn right onto Pine Creek and take the first left onto East Pine Creek Road. Continue onto Old Perry Highway. About 1/2 mile up the hill the school will be on the right side. Enter the building at Entrance #1. (10090 Old Perry Hwy)

Wexford Elementary School, Pine Richland (724) 935-4631

Take I-279 N to the US-19-N exit (number 11). Stay on Rt. 19 N and travel past North Allegheny High School. Go several miles further until you come to a traffic light at the intersection with Brown Road. (CVS will be on the right). Turn right onto Brown Road. Wexford Elementary is 1/2 mile on the left. (250 Brown Road)

Winchester Thurston Lower School, Oakland (412) 578-3723

Go up Forbes Avenue heading away from the University of Pittsburgh towards Squirrel Hill. Just past the Carnegie Library and after the light at Craig Street the CMU campus will be on the right side of Forbes. Turn left onto Morewood Avenue. Winchester Thurston will be on the right side at the second light. (555 Morewood Avenue)

Winchester Thurston North Hills Campus, Hampton Township (412) 486-8341

Take 579 North towards the Veterans Bridge. Follow signs to Allegheny Valley Expressway/PA 28 toward Etna. Merge onto PA 28. Go approximately 4 1/4 miles to PA 8 North via exit number 5B toward Butler. The exit will be on the left. Stay on PA 8 North for approximately 1 1/2 miles. Turn right onto Saxonburg Boulevard. Turn left immediately onto Middle Road. Middle Road winds through a residential area for several miles. As soon as you pass the Hartwood Acres concert entrance and Central Elementary School on your right, the school will be on your left.

Directions to Schools outside of Pittsburgh Area

Aquinas Academy, Greensburg (724) 834-7940

Routes 30, 119, and 66 all lead into downtown Greensburg and Main Street. The school is located approximately 1/2 mile north of the courthouse (located on Main Street) and next to the Blessed Sacrament Cathedral Church. Park in front of the school. (340 North Main Street)

C.F. Patton Middle School, Kennett Square (610)-347-2000

From 202 take 926 W. to Rt. 82 toward Unionville. Patton Middle School is at 760 Unionville Rd. (Rt. 82) in Unionville. From Rt. 1 S. in Kennett Square, turn onto Rt. 82 toward Unionville.(760 Unionville Road)

Forest Hills High School, Sidman (814) 487-7613

From Rt. 219, take the Sidman/St. Michael exit. Take Route 869 East approximately 1 1/2 miles through St. Michael. The school is directly across from Morris Tavern. Turn into the driveway; the high school is the yellow brick building. (489 Locust Street)

Glenside Elementary School, Cheltenham (215) 881-6440

From the Pennsylvania Turnpike (I-276), take exit 339 toward Philadelphia/Ambler (Route 309). Merge onto Route 309 South toward Philadelphia by taking the exit on the left. After approximately 4.5 miles, take the exit toward Glenside. Take a slight right onto S. Easton Road and then turn left on Limeclin Pike. You will see Arcadia University on the left. Proceed less than half a mile to the elementary school.

Indiana University of PA, Indiana**(724) 357-2608**

Take US 22 east to Blairsville. Merge onto US 119 N to Indiana. Merge onto Wayne Avenue. Turn left onto Maple Street and then turn right onto S 11th Street. Turn right onto Oakland Avenue. Turn left onto South 10th St. On the left is a three-story building called Stright Hall. There is paid parking available behind the building or metered parking on the streets. (210 S 10th Street)

Learning Enrichment Center, Warren**(814) 723-0574**

Turn left onto Elm Street following Route 62 north. Merge onto Route 6 east. Take the US-6BR E/US-62 ramp. Keep following Route 62, making a slight right onto Ludlow Street. Turn right onto Pennsylvania Avenue. Turn left onto Laurel Street. Turn right onto 4th Avenue. Turn left onto Market Street. Turn right onto Owens Road and turn right again onto Hospital Drive. The Learning Center is on the right side of the street. (185 Hospital Drive)

Linntown Elementary School, Lewisburg**(570) 523-3220**

Take Route 15 to Route 45. Take Route 45 to 20th Street. At 20th Street, turn south for one block to the Linntown Elementary School. (1901 Washington Avenue)

Windber Research Institute, Windber**(814) 467-9844**

From Route 219 heading toward Johnstown take Scalp Ave. PA-56 east toward Windber. From 56-E take the PA 601 ramp toward Scalp Level/Paint. Turn right onto PA 601/Main St. Turn right onto Bedford St. Bedford St. becomes Graham Ave. Turn left onto 7th St. The building is located on the right side of the road. (620 Seventh Street)
