Wired Connect the appropriate cable to your device.

Wireless

- 1. Tap **Wireless Presentation** on the panel.
- 2. Follow the steps on the screen to **connect your device**.
- 3. Tap End Presentation to disconnect.

Touch Panel

Tap to refresh the touch panel.

U Turn off when complete.



DISPLAY ONE DEVICE

1. Tap the touch panel to wake the system.

USE VIDEOCONFERENCE FOR HYBRID OR REMOTE INSTRUCTION

- 2. Under **Devices**, tap the device that you want to display.

DISPLAY MULTIPLE DEVICES

- 1. Under **Display Controls**, tap **Left-**, **Right-** or **Both-** to set the display location for an additional device.
- 2. Under **Devices**, tap the additional device to display.
- 3. (Optional) Under **Display Controls**, tap **Blank Screen/Unblank Screen** to toggle on/off room screens in the corresponding location.

PREVIEW DEVICE ON TOUCH PANEL

- 1. Under Actions, select Video Preview.
- 2. Tap **Left Display, Right Display** or **Desktop** to designate the device to display on the touch panel.
- 3. Tap the **arrow** to return to the touch panel menu.

- 1. Connect the **USB cable**, labeled Conferencing, and the **HDMI cable** to your laptop.
- 2. Tap **Conferencing** on the touch panel.
- 3. Open the **Zoom app** then select **zoom.us > Preferences**.
- 4. Set the following:
 - Video USB Capture SDI+
 - Audio (Speaker) Crestron (Crestron)
 - Audio (Microphone) TesiraFORTE
- 5. Tap **Video** on the touch screen to adjust camera settings.
- 6. Use **Zoom** to share your screen.
- 7. Tap **Presentation** then the **device** you want to share.
