*Note: Students should make flight arrangements to arrive in Madrid on the Sunday prior to the start of classes. The 4-week program entitles students to 28 nights of housing (through the Saturday night after the last day of classes). Students participating in the 6-week program will depart by train from Madrid for Alicante or Salamanca on Friday or Saturday of the fourth week to begin classes on Monday of the fifth week. After completing the program in Alicante or Salamanca, if students plan to return to the U.S. directly after the program, they may return to Madrid, usually to their first host family, for a night of housing prior to departure.). The above dates are general guidelines; other dates may be available, please contact tardio@andrew.cmu.edu if you have questions about the dates.

- 4-week Madrid Program: \$3,513. (surcharge possible, depending on foreign exchange rates)
- 8-week Madrid & Alicante/Salamanca Program: \$6,055. (surcharge possible for arranging a student internship or for major fluctuation in currency exchange rate).
