BXA Small Grant Application

The BXA Interdisciplinary Degree Programs periodically have funds available to students in need. These funds are reserved for BHA, BSA, and BCSA students who: 1) plan to study abroad with an international program that is not currently sponsored by Carnegie Mellon, 2) plan to have an unpaid internship over the summer, 3) plan to work on an undergraduate research project, a capstone project, or other student project that requires a small budget.

Please keep in mind that funds are not always available for BXA small grants. The distribution of BXA small grants is at the discretion of the Director of the BXA Interdisciplinary Degree Programs.

To be eligible, you must be a BHA, BSA, or BCSA student in good standing (3.0 QPA and above)

Additional information needed:

- **For internships**, you must complete a BXA Internship Agreement, obtain a supervisor on site, and receive academic credit for the internship.
- **For study abroad**, you must provide information on the international program that is not currently sponsored by Carnegie Mellon.
- **For student projects**, you must provide a project proposal and a project budget.
