ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 7th day of May, 2014, upon consideration of the Report and Recommendation filed by court-appointed Special Master, the Honorable Thomas T. Frampton, on April 21, 2014, wherein he recommends that the Court approve the proposed supersedeas bond submitted by Defendants Marvell Technology Group and Marvell Semiconductor, Inc. (“Marvell”), and stay enforcement of the final judgment upon the Court’s approval of the supersedeas bond, (Docket No. [940]), Plaintiff Carnegie Mellon University’s Objection to 4/21/14 Report and Recommendation, (Docket No. [944]), and Marvell’s Response to CMU’s Objection to the Special Master’s April 21, 2014 Report and Recommendation, (Docket No. [946]),

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that CMU’s Objections [944] are OVERRULED;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Report and Recommendation filed by the Special Master on April 21, 2014 [940] is adopted as the Opinion of the Court;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the proposed supersedeas bond (Docket No. 946-2) is APPROVED and Marvell shall proceed to obtain final execution of same and file the final bond for the Court’s endorsement and final approval by **May 14, 2014 at 5:00 p.m.**;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, as no objections were raised to the Court's Proposed Final Judgment by the Court's April 22, 2014 deadline, (Docket No. [938]), the Court will finalize and enter the Final Judgment forthwith; and,

FINALLY, IT IS ORDERED that upon the Court's final approval of the bond, the enforcement of the Final Judgment will be STAYED pending the disposition of any appeals of this matter and the forthcoming recommendation by the Special Master on the "separate" issue of whether Marvell should be required to post any additional security for the ongoing royalties and any attendant objections and/or motions practice by the parties related to same are fully resolved by this Court.
