AND NOW, this 31st day of March, 2014, in accordance with the foregoing Memorandum Opinion,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that CMU's Motion for Prejudgment and Post-Judgment Interest, (Docket No. [788]), Motion for a Permanent Injunction, Post-Judgment Royalties, and Supplemental Damages, (Docket No. [786]), and Motion for a Finding of Willful Infringement and Enhanced Damages, (Docket No. [790]) are GRANTED, IN PART and DENIED, IN PART. As explained therein, CMU's requests for prejudgment interest and a permanent injunction are denied and its requests for supplemental damages, enhanced damages, post-judgment interest and an ongoing royalty are granted. A summary of the damages award is, as follows:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall meet and confer and file a proposed final judgment with the Court by **12:00 p.m. on April 15, 2014**;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall proceed with diligence to continue to negotiate the bond issues with the court-appointed Special Master in accordance with the Court's Prior Orders (Docket Nos. 928, 930); and,

FINALLY, IT IS ORDERED that the parties shall meet and confer and provide the Court with a joint status report regarding the continuing infringement by <u>5:00 p.m. on May 1, 2014</u>, detailing all of Marvell's U.S. and overseas (worldwide) sales for the period of November 3, 2013 until as close to May 1, 2014 as possible. The parties shall then proceed to file quarterly joint status reports containing the same information for subsequent periods on the first business day of the months of August, November, February and May, until any appeals of this matter are resolved. To the extent that this process engenders disputes among the parties, the Court will appoint a Special Master to resolve same.
