A CEE student who does not meet the above criteria but has demonstrated academic excellence otherwise may petition to gain admittance to the IMB program by submitting a completed petition form to the Department Head. Petitions may be submitted when a student is at least a 2nd semester Junior and has completed at least 250 units, and any time thereafter before the completion of the BS degree.

An approved petition will grant a student admission into the IMB program upon the successful completion of his/her BS degree in CEE (at which point the student enters the program as a CEE graduate student). Any eligible course credits not applied toward a student's BS degree may be applied toward the student's MS degree.
