Music Pre-College Scholarship Guidelines

Eligibility

Students must formally apply to the Music Pre-College program by submitting an application (<u>click here to apply</u>) in order to be considered for a scholarship. Students may complete and submit the scholarship application (second page of this document) at any time, but scholarship applications will not be reviewed until the student has been admitted into the Music program.

Please note: Only one scholarship may be awarded per student and the scholarship is only for a partial amount. Scholarships are only available to students enrolled in the **6 week session**. Scholarships are not available to international students.

It is not a requirement that the chamber group perform together before applying, only that members prepare an audition piece for the application. The chamber group of 3 or more players may be created specially for the purposes of this scholarship.

Submission Requirements

Scholarship applications are reviewed on a rolling basis. Scholarship applications may be submitted at any time, but will not be reviewed until all of the students of the applying group are each **admitted into the program**. In addition to the scholarship application, students are required to submit **one recording** of the chamber group (3 or more students) playing together. Your recording should reveal strengths and be representative of your level of musical performance. **All members of the chamber group must submit a separate scholarship application**, but only one member needs to submit the audition recording. On the application (second page), indicate which student is submitting the recording.

The following file formats will be accepted: Audio/Video Extensions = .mp3, .m4a, .aiff, .wma, .wav, .aac, .mpeg, .mpg, .mp4, .mov, .avi, .wmv, .m4v

Submit the recording via email to <u>music-precollege@cmu.edu</u>. If the file is too large to attach to the body of the email, include a link (i.e. YouTube, Soundcloud, BOX, Dropbox) to your recording.
