<b>Transitional</b>  The university has established guidance and provided risk mitigation protocols to ensure continued adherence to COVID-19 safety measures during a transitional period of returning to campus. Targeted mitigation strategies are implemented as needed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In-person instruction is predominant with remote instruction on a limited basis</li> <li>• Re-densification of housing and dining facilities</li> <li>• Non-curricular student activities aligned with university risk mitigation protocols do not require preapproval</li> <li>• Shared spaces are open with modifications</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In addition to essential functions, on-campus delivery of services supporting core education and research functions are prioritized</li> <li>• Many units transition to the on-campus workplace with flexible arrangements, such as a rotating presence on campus</li> <li>• In-person, on-campus events aligned with university risk mitigation protocols do not require preapproval</li> </ul>
	Increased capacity for on-site research activities consistent with university risk mitigation protocols Visitors permitted	
<b>Modified</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Temporary adjustment of course modalities towards more remote options</li> <li>• Dining facilities and services modified: takeout meals only</li> <li>• Non-curricular student activities require preapproval</li> <li>• Shared spaces and facilities modified as needed (i.e., athletic facilities)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In addition to essential functions, on-campus delivery of services supporting core education and research functions continue to be prioritized</li> <li>• Temporarily pause further transition to the on-campus workplace</li> <li>• In-person, on-campus events require preapproval</li> </ul>
	Approved on-site research activities continue subject to any additional requirements from the Vice President for Research Visitors permitted, in some cases subject to approval Non-essential university business travel paused	
<b>Restricted</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Remote study temporarily required, with exceptions considered</li> <li>• De-densified housing and dining facilities</li> <li>• In-person student activities and gatherings temporarily suspended</li> <li>• Limited shared spaces open with modifications to support physical distancing (i.e., CUC reduced hours)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Remote work, events and meetings for most academic, administrative and operational units</li> <li>• Essential services continue</li> <li>• Academic instruction may be delivered remotely using on-campus learning facilities</li> </ul>
	Approved on-site research activities may continue subject to any additional requirements from the Vice President for Research Visitors permitted subject to approval	
<b>Essential Services Only</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Remote study required</li> <li>• Reduction in housing and dining facilities – residential students who can relocate home are encouraged to do so</li> <li>• Gatherings prohibited</li> <li>• Facilities only open to support on-campus students and essential services</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Remote work, events and meetings required</li> <li>• Essential on-campus services only (i.e., Facilities Management, Postal Services, etc.)</li> </ul>
	Approved on-site research activities may continue subject to any additional requirements from the Vice President for Research Visitors only permitted by special exception
