Cleotilde Gonzalez, associate research professor in the Department of Social and Decision Sciences and director of the Dynamic Decision Making Laboratory, recently spoke to a large group of faculty in computer science, psychology and management at the Wyższa Szkoła Biznesu (National-Louis University) in Nowy Sacz, Poland. In collaboration with Christian Lebiere, a research faculty member in the Department of Psychology, Gonzalez recently obtained a five-year, \$1.75 million grant from the Defense Threat Reduction Agency to conduct basic research to determine the socio-cognitive factors that lead to conflict between two constituencies and the factors that aid in conflict resolution. Gonzalez also is investigating solutions for the Cyber Situation Awareness problem through a five-year, multimillion dollar Multi-University Research Initiative grant in collaboration with Penn State University and Arizona State University.
