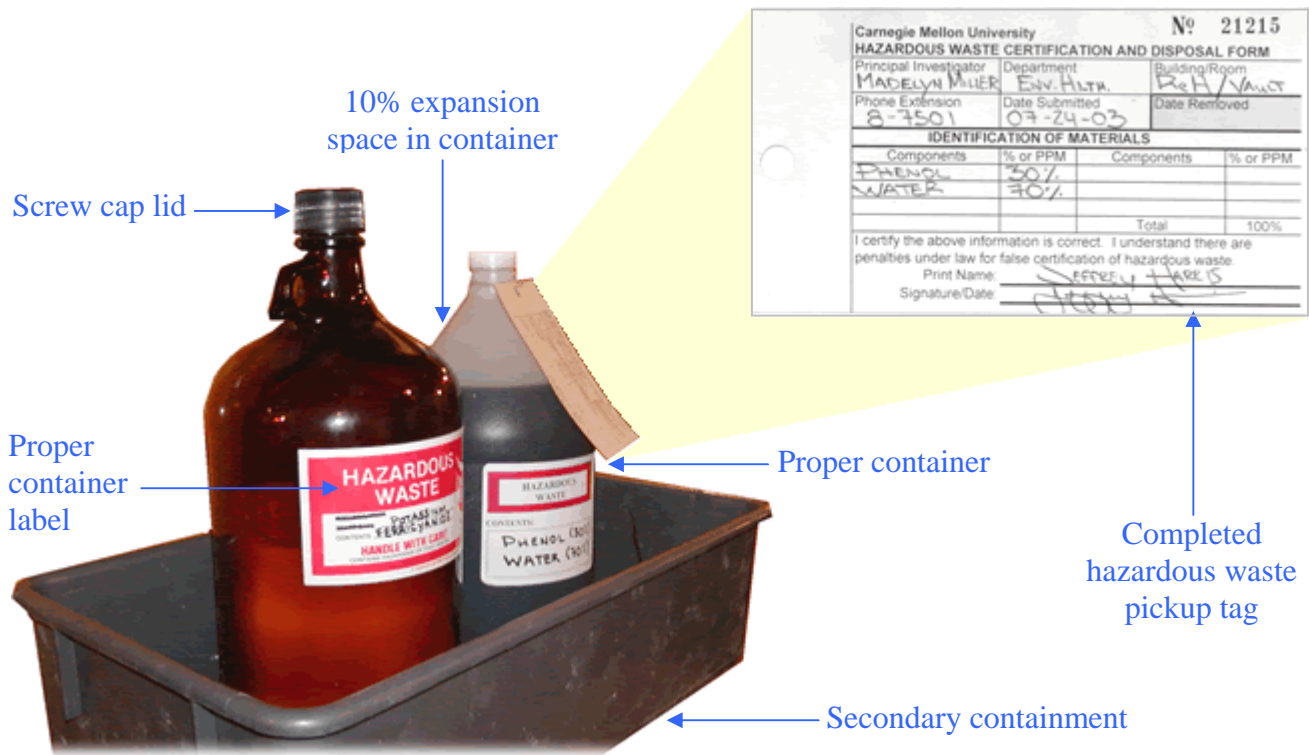


Hazardous Waste Guidelines



Proper accumulation of hazardous waste is an *EPA requirement!*
Here's how you can help:

- *Contain waste properly*- container must be in good physical condition with a screw cap lid, "Hazardous Waste" label, and secondary containment.
- *Keep container closed*- open only for duration of material transfer.
- *Prepare a complete Hazardous Waste Certification and Disposal Form* and secure to container prior to disposal.
- *Identify each and every component* of waste products and list on the disposal form.
- *Maintain user training*- all waste generators must attend EH&S Hazardous Waste Training and periodic refresher courses.
- *Remove "dead wood" from chemical storage*- old, expired, unused, and unneeded hazardous chemicals must be properly disposed of as hazardous waste.
