
Hazardous Waste Guidelines



Proper accumulation of hazardous waste is an *EPA requirement*! Here's how *you* can help:

- *Contain waste properly* container must be in good physical condition with a screw cap lid, "Hazardous Waste" label, and secondary containment.
- *Keep container closed* open only for duration of material transfer.
- Prepare a complete Hazardous Waste Certification and Disposal Form and secure to container prior to disposal.
- *Identify each and every component* of waste products and list on the disposal form.
- *Maintain user training* all waste generators <u>must</u> attend EH&S Hazardous Waste Training and periodic refresher courses.
- *Remove "dead wood" from chemical storage* old, expired, unused, and unneeded hazardous chemicals <u>must</u> be properly disposed of as hazardous waste.
