

Personal Sharps Management

To support the health and safety of our campus community, EHS is excited to introduce the new Personal Sharps Management Program. This initiative is designed to help prevent accidental injuries from personal sharps, such as those used for medications like insulin, allergy treatments or migraine prevention. Proper disposal of sharps is essential to maintain a safe environment for everyone. As part of the program, students can request sharps containers to safely store used needles and syringes by contacting safety@andrew.cmu.edu or visiting University Health Services (UHS). Students may be asked a few questions to determine what size sharps container would be appropriate for their needs.

Additionally, designated sharps drop-off points have been established on campus for convenient and secure disposal of sharps in the following locations:

- University Police Department
- Mellon Institute Room 315 (EHS Office)
