- ✓ Paperboard (cereal/shoe boxes)
- ✓ Paper ream wrappers
- ✓ Post-It notes
- ✓ Soft & Hard covered books
- ✓ Telephone directories
- ✓ White/colored paper
- ✓ White/colored envelopes with windows

### Cardboard

- ✓ Corrugated boxes

### Glass, Plastic, Metals

- ✓ Aluminum cans
- ✓ Plastic bottles #1 & #2 jars, tubs and jugs 3 gallons or less - (milk, water, juice, pop, detergent) no caps, lids or liquids
- ✓ Steel cans, including empty aerosol cans
- ✓ Unbroken glass bottles of any color

- ✓ Labeled 'Compostable' products made from either corn, sugar cane or potato starch
