# **Release Highlights**

### **Cross-Cutting**

- As part of the COVID-19 campus response, made modifications to SIO whereby student-initiated verifications may only be produced as a pdf
- Created an automated process for precollege forfeits to increase efficiency and accuracy.

#### Admission

- Resolved an issue where applicants were unable to log in to their online portal and view their application status if Powerfaids was down.
- As part of the COVID-19 campus response, made adjustments to the Where Am I in the Process applicant-portal that will help with the waitlist process.

# Registrar

- **Feature Item:** Modified course section types to match the new budget model that becomes effective in Fall 2020. This included:
  - Retiring some existing section types
  - Creating new section types
- Ensured the graduation cap on the enter-grades screen displays correctly for students with more than one degree.

 Resolved an email error that occurred when sending a Notice of Return email from National Automated Clearing House Association (NACHA)

- Emergency work for the p/np policy implemented for the Spring 2020 semester
- The first phase of the MyCommunity project continues, which includes:
  - A wider range of advisor roles will be able to be assigned to students, such as First Year Advisor and Faculty Advisor
  - The ability for S3 users to assign, update, and remove advisors via a CSV upload
