Release Highlights

Cross-Cutting

- Improved the ADA compliance in some screens in SIO
- Added missing file extensions (.pdf) to course photo rosters and decision letters displayed in the Where am I application

University Registrar Office

• Fixed an issue where the student's Enrollment status page sometimes displayed the major of a previously-certified degree, rather than the major of the in-progress degree of the requested semester

Admission

- Added new validation to assist with data integrity for new incoming documents for applicants
- Redesigned the display of incoming documents in the Where am I in the Process application
- Added IELTS scores to the display on the Where am I in the Process application

Coming in the Next Six Months...

- Continued additions and changes in the S3 Suite to support the university's response to COVID-19
- Improvements to the "Where am I in the Process" app to help applicants better understand what documents and test scores have been received by the Undergraduate Admission office
- A complete revision of the "My Info" section in SIO that both modernizes and refreshes the look and feel
- The next phase of the MyCommunity project continues, which includes:
 - A wider range of advisor roles will be able to be assigned to students, such as First Year Advisor and Faculty Advisor
 - The ability for S3 users to assign, update, and remove advisors via a CSV upload
