- Improvements to more easily provide required information to the National Student Clearinghouse, including:
 - Setting a student's First Semester Enrolled and updating the information when changes are made
 - Tracking changes made to student records for degrees and additional majors

- Continued additions and changes in the S3 Suite to support the university's response to COVID-19
- Modifications to the Voucher process to incorporate recent policy changes
- The ability to assign a wider range of advisor roles to students, such as First Year Advisor and Faculty Advisor
