## Release Highlights

### Cross-cutting

- Added the capability for students with a registration hold to process vouchers in Student Information Online (SIO)
- Added an email link to the i-circle of processed vouchers

### Registrar

- Improved the loading time and behavior for course rosters impacted by delays from Namecoach
- Improved the loading time for student pages impacted by delays from Namecoach

### Admission

- Added the capability for Admission staff to edit whether an applicant wishes to have their test scores considered during the review of their application
- Modernized and improved the follow-up correspondence process for applicants who are missing documentation
- Created a view and update Course Preparation section to allow updates to the course preparation data by support staff during the application review process.
- Updated the look and feel of “Where am I in the Process” (WAI), the portal for undergraduate applicants to check on the status of their application and materials
- Added the new TOEFL Essentials test scores to the types of test scores applicants can view in WAI
