Release Highlights

Cross-cutting

- Updates to Student Information Online (SIO) to ensure a student's preferred name displays anytime the name is visible
- Fixed a defect in SIO that displayed an incorrect symbol next to the housing cost instead of a dollar sign
- Fixed a defect in S3 Admin Console (S3) that caused an error when updating records for Qatar Summer Preview students
- Implemented logging in S3 that will help inform future decisions regarding user-experience and user support

Registrar

• Added the ability in s3 for University Registrar's staff to submit and process an Administrative Pass / No Pass Voucher after the deadline has passed

Admission

- Added the new TOEFL Essentials test scores to the types of test scores Admission staff can view and edit in S3
- Added an indicator to an applicant's screen if required scores have not been received by that applicant

Coming in the next six months to one year...

- Required changes to meet updated Nacha regulations
- Expanded functionality due to new types of tests being accepted by the university and changes to score requirements
