

Release #4 introduced significant registration functionality to S3 and SIO. Beginning with Summer 2012 and Fall 2012 registration, students will no longer use OLR. Instead, students will use SIO to plan their schedule, register, and view & update their waitlisted courses. When some of these registration SIS screens were “replicated” in S3, several aspects of new functionality were added.

Release Highlights

In SIO

- SIO Registration
 - Includes an updated look and lets the student register directly from their planned schedule, browse for a course to register, drop a course, switch from one course to another, switch from one section to another, and view & manage their waitlist

In S3 Admin Console

- Student Screens
 - Student Registration
 - Includes student’s registration time assignment, advisor, max units, registration hold, schedule, and waitlist information
 - Authorized users will be able to update advisor, max units, and holds; drop, add, and switch student courses; take action on waitlisted students
- Course Screens
 - Waitlist Maintenance - Now includes ability to register students from the waitlist and e-mail all or some of the students who are waitlisted for a particular course/section
 - Course Message – View/update messages displayed in SIO per course & semester
 - Student Reservations – View/update section cap, max, and reservations
 - Course Drops – Sortable list of students who have dropped the course, per semester
- S3 Time-out
 - Users will receive a warning message 10 minutes before their S3 session times out
 - Log out and time-out will remove ERP login, but will not remove the user’s Andrew login

Corrected Technical Issues:

- ✓ Improve the logic that drives which semester is displayed, and holding the semester from one screen to the next
- ✓ Adjusted the data displayed on the Student: Waitlist screen
- ✓ Improved text display on all S3 screens

Related Functionality Not Yet Released

- Student screens: Complete contact information for student and listed ‘Family & Friends’
- Student screens: SIO Admin features such as Unofficial Academic Record

Coming in the Next Six Months...

- Development of Financial aid screens
- Fine tune authorization for S3 users
- Development and release of some Undergraduate Admission screens

Identified Technical Issues:

- Continue to update/correct displayed data such as Student - Advisor; Course - Begin semester and Last Offered semester
- Eliminate invalid/irrelevant options from the Search and other drop-down lists
