Cross-Cutting

- **FFP Feature Item:** Introduced new functionality that permits the URO office to change program codes to match a degree that is on a student’s record but is not the Primary Degree

Student Accounts

- **FFP Feature Item:** Created the ability for the Student Accounts office to post Anticipated Transactions on a student’s account
- Updated the 1098T pdf to be in compliance with new federal regulations

Coming in the Next Six Months...

- The ability for students to view some anticipated transactions on their student accounts in SIO
- The ability for advisors to place and lift bulk registration holds on their advisees
- The ability for departments to bulk update academic advisor assignments
