New Features

- Sorting preferences for advisee search is now saved and persistent for future uses
- When loading data from the university, Stellic's student data task now automatically deletes past plan-slots/placeholders and records a corresponding plan activity for it
- New design for "help" floating beacons. Previously, the red-color dot was unclear to the students. So we added a blue color with "?": in it
- Control Default View settings (official vs planned audit view, compact vs expanded view, etc.) directly from User Settings sidebar
- Published and validated Spring 2019 Schedule
- Manually updated Pittsburgh calendar
- Updated Student Parser to ingest newly available data for students (certified degrees, current campus, mid-semester grades, term joined, etc.)
- Certified Degrees.
- Updated Course Parser now distinguishes "grad" and "undergrad" for courses
- Set Units for Courses not in the Feeder File Using student's course history
- Moved daily cron job forward by 30 minutes

Fixed Issues

- Non-superadmins were not able to search for advisors.
- Allow Group members to view other members of the group (previously, only superadmins can do this)
- Fix bug of the unofficial audit version not getting refreshed after sharing a shared requirement.
- When deselecting Show CQPA and Progress bar, the progress bar and QPA information did not automatically disappear.
- Hide progress bar in a student's profile when no audit for any of the student's enrolled programs are available.
- CSV now restricts to saved search students.
- Activate the "Show More" button in search advisee with saved searches.

- Export CSV error when some students' email addresses were not defined.
- Speed fix (Firefox specific): Yellow banner was appearing notifying of website slowing down.
- Fix ampersand escaping issue in the program and shared requirement name.
- Rebuilt index of Shared Requirement audit after changing program name
- Xml malformed character removal that was preventing us from reading the files
- Added D- grade
- Invalid Request error on remove exception on a root requirement
- Students are not able to lookup some courses through quick search feature
