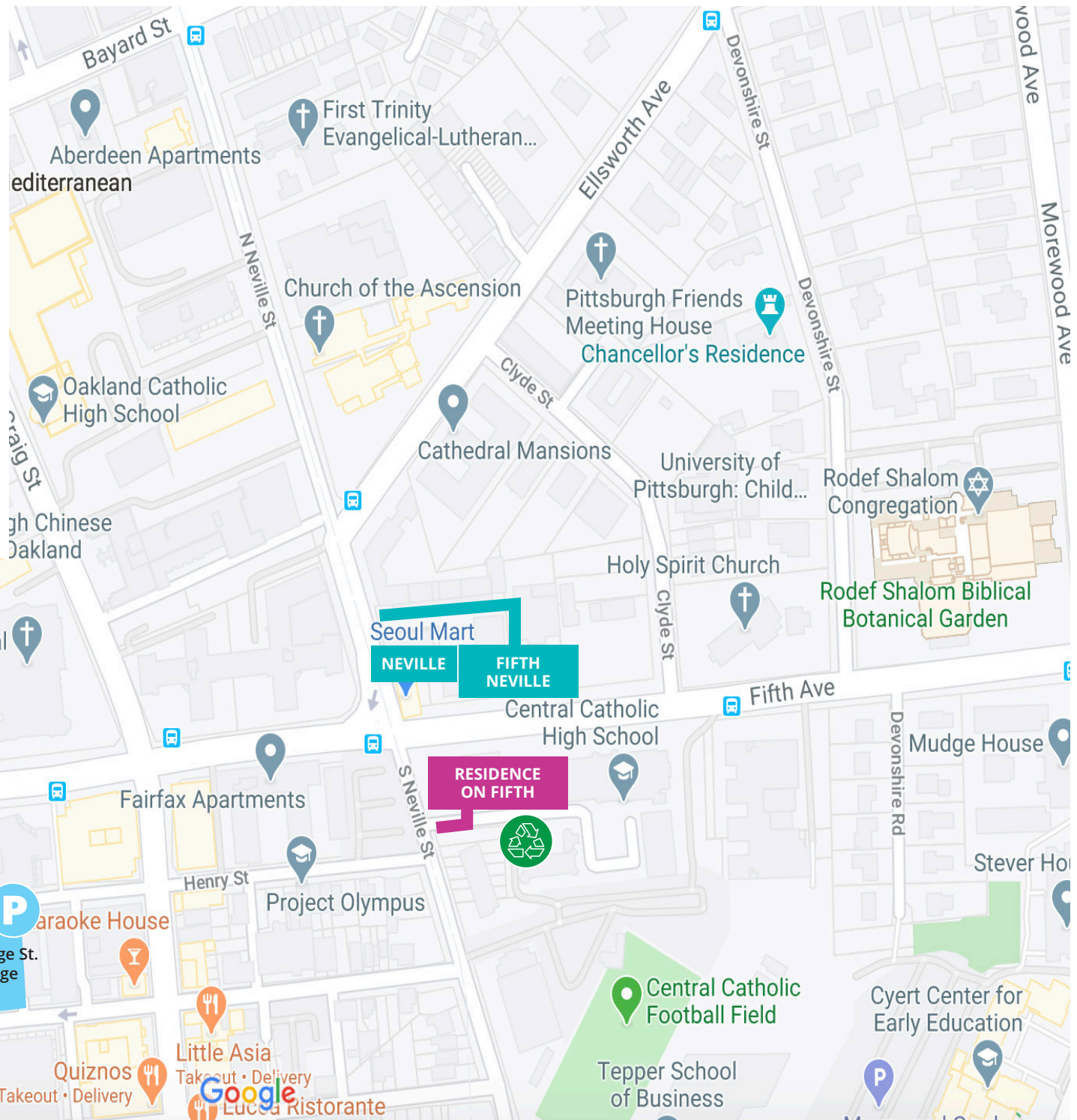


# Residence on Fifth, Neville and Fifth Neville Move-in Map

# Residence on Fifth, Neville and Fifth Neville



## Unloading

During your timeslot, please unload your car in one of the designated unloading zones.

- **Neville Apartment & Fifth Neville Apartments:** Upper level parking lot. Entrance is located just north of 619 S Neville St.
- **Residence on Fifth:** Parking garage under Residence on Fifth. Entrance is located near 198 S Neville St. (only available 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. daily)

While in the unloading zone, do not leave your vehicle unattended. Please move your vehicle to one of the three move-in day parking locations listed below by the end of your timeslot.



## Parking

On your move-in day, you may park your vehicle at one of the following locations:

- **Dithridge Street Garage**, 252 S Dithridge St., Pittsburgh, PA 15213, \$16 per weekday, \$5 per weekend day
- **East Campus Garage**, 5040 Forbes Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15213, \$12 per weekday, Free on weekend days
- **Morewood Lot Gated Section**, 1046 Morewood Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15213, Free during move-in



## Facial Covering and Physical Distancing

All residents and those assisting residents on move-in day must wear a facial covering while in the residential facilities. The only exception is when inside a student's private room. Also please maintain physical distancing of at least 6 feet from

other residents and move-in groups. This includes limiting the number of individuals on an elevator, in community hallways and in shared suite or apartment spaces.



## ID Card Pickup

New first-year residents who did not receive an ID during fall semester and did not have a domestic mailing address on file can pick up their ID card from the Residence on Fifth (4700 Fifth Ave.) front desk during or shortly before their move-in timeslot. ***A photo ID is required to pick up a student ID. Additionally, the ID card will only be issued to the individual student.***



## Lock Outs

If you are locked out of your room, there are multiple ways to gain access.

- You can utilize the **CBORD Mobile ID app** to receive a six-digit temporary lock-out code.
- Call the **Housing Services office** (412-268-2139) at the Residence on Fifth Monday through Friday during business hours (8:30 a.m. – 5 p.m.) to receive a temporary access code. During move-in, office hours are 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. daily.
- If no other options are available, contact **University Police** (412-268-2323) after hours for lock-out assistance.



## Trash

During move-in, trash will need to be taken to the nearby dumpsters. A map of dumpster locations will be available at move-in. No large items are permitted in the trash receptacles in the building hallways during move-in.
