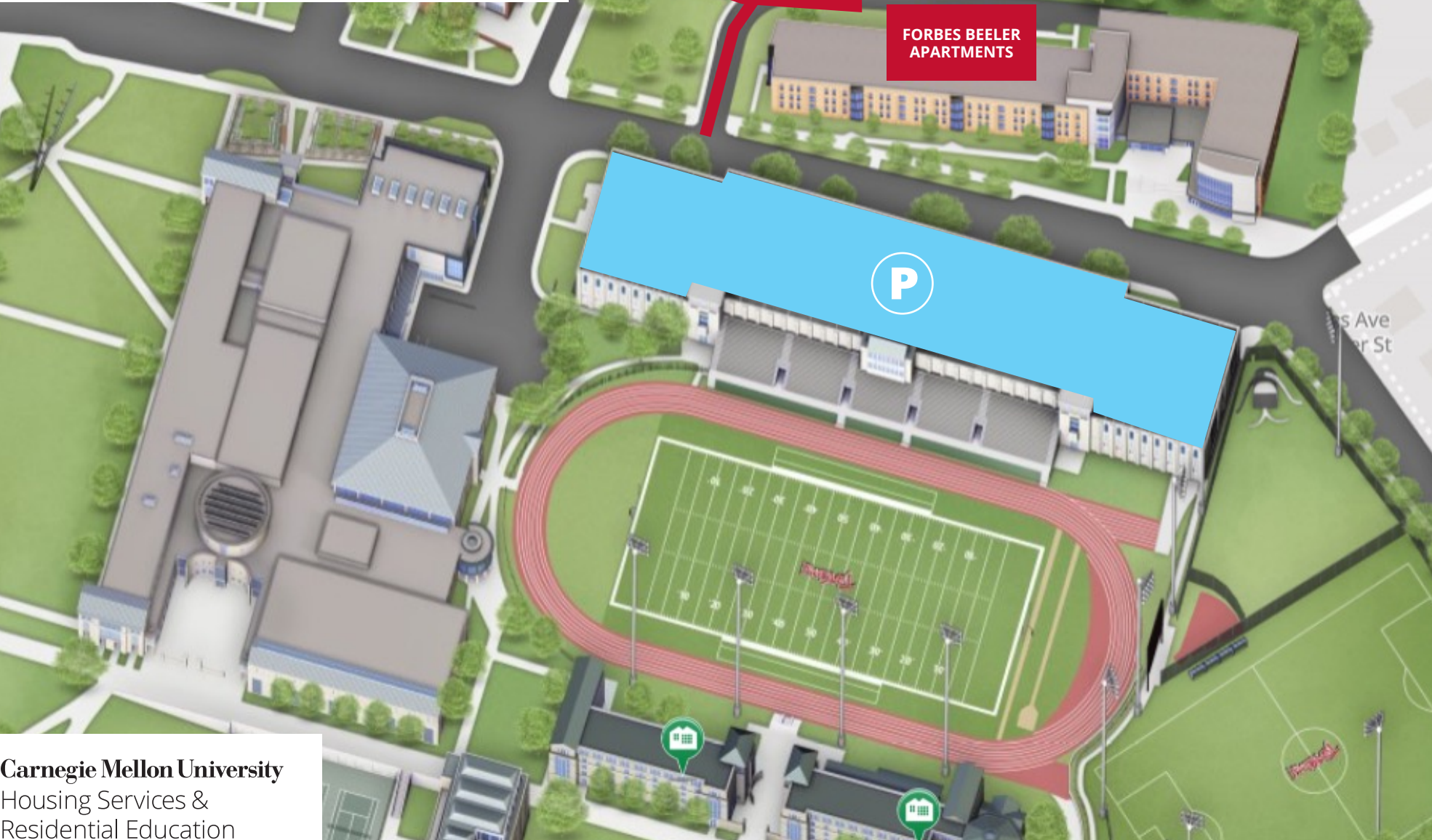


Forbes Beeler Apartments Move-in Map

Upperclass Move-In

Upperclass move-in begins on Wednesday, August 19, through Sunday, August 23. You must sign up for a move-in timeslot for one of these five days. Please email rmassign@andrew.cmu.edu if you will be arriving after August 23.



Unloading

During your timeslot, please unload your car in the designated unloading zone. While in the unloading zone, do not leave your vehicle unattended. Please move your vehicle to one of the three move-in day parking locations listed by the end of your timeslot.



Lock Outs

If you are locked out of your room, there are multiple ways to gain access.

- You can utilize the **CBORD Mobile ID app** to receive a six-digit one-time use lock-out code. Scan the QR code to download the app.
- Call the **Housing Services** office (412-268-2139) at the Residence on Fifth Monday through Friday during business hours (8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.) to receive a one-time use access code.
- Call the **Residence on Fifth Service Desk** (412-268-1518) during desk hours (weekdays 5 p.m. to 10 p.m., and weekends 9 a.m. to 10 p.m., beginning August 16) to receive a one-time use lock-out code.
- Contact **University Police** (412-268-2323) after hours (10 p.m. to 8:30 a.m.) for lock-out assistance.



Parking

On your move-in day, you may park your vehicle at one of the following locations:

- Dithridge Street Garage:** 252 S Dithridge St., Pittsburgh, PA 15213, \$26 per weekday, \$15 per weekend day
- East Campus Garage:** 5040 Forbes Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15213, \$22 per weekday, free on weekend days and weekdays after 5 p.m. with CMU ID card
- Morewood Lot Gated Section:** 1046 Morewood Ave., Pittsburgh, PA 15213, free on weekend days and weekdays after 5 p.m.

Handicap accessible parking is available.



ID Cards

Returning upperclass students should be sure to bring their CMU ID card with them to campus.

Transfer students who did not receive their ID card in the mail must pick up their CMU ID at Transfer Orientation on August 19 between 12:30-2 p.m. in Simmons A, Tepper Quad, or on August 21 between 2-4 p.m. in Danforth Conference Room, Cohon University Center.

Exchange students who did not receive their ID card in the mail must pick up their ID card from the Residence on Fifth (4700 Fifth Ave.) front desk during or shortly before their move-in timeslot. The Residence on Fifth desk will be open from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m. during upper-class move-in days. ***A photo ID is required to pick up a student ID and the ID card will only be issued to the individual student. Any resident who forgot or lost their ID will need to visit Cyert Hall to get a new card.***



Trash

During move-in, trash must be taken to the nearby dumpsters. No large items are permitted in the trash receptacles in the building hallways during move-in.
