### Financial Aid Process

Carnegie Mellon's [My Student Aid \(MSA\)](#) portal allows you to track the status of your financial aid application, submit supporting documentation and forms, review your financial aid offer and estimated cost of attendance, and accept, reduce or decline your loans. If you applied for financial aid and additional documentation is still needed, you may receive an email directing you to log in to MSA for further instructions or information. It's important to submit requested documents as soon as possible to ensure your financial aid funds are applied to your student account in a timely manner for the fall semester.
