The HCII Social Cybersecurity group is conducting an interview study in spring & summer 2020 seeking data about cybersecurity adoption in the social context of the workplace. We have added questions about how the Covid-19 situation and the associated shift to remote work are affecting how people share accounts and devices in a usable and secure way. The results will be analyzed and submitted as research papers to either the ACM CHI 2021 or CSCW 2021 conferences.
