



Summer 2023 Experiential Learning Requirement Guidelines

The **Experiential Learning Requirement** at the Integrated Innovation Institute is predominantly completed by students through a summer internship. Depending on flexibility within specific degrees, students might find alternative experiences through summer research on campus or applying as a summer team to VentureBridge.

Students will register for the following courses to complete this requirement:

- 49-746 Integrated Innovation Institute Internship

To complete this requirement, students must work for a minimum of 9 weeks, with at least 20 hours of work per week at an experiential learning opportunity related to their degree.

To complete the Experiential Learning Requirement with an internship, please review the additional details below.

Internships

An internship start date will be at the discretion of the employer based on the summer academic term dates. We anticipate students will start employment between May 15 and June 1, 2023. We highly recommend all students start working prior to June 1.

Please note that international students requiring Curriculum Practicum Training (CPT) authorization are only eligible to work during the following dates per the Office of International Education (OIE).

First Day of Internship: Monday, May 15, 2023

Last Day of Internship: Friday, August 25, 2023

Compensation

Students are eligible to receive a salary/hourly wage/stipend directly from the employer during the summer internship. While we encourage compensation for our students, it is not required of the hiring company.
