1. The message display name "Carnegie Mellon University" does not match the email address domain.

2. The message contains a suspicious attachment.

3. The message uses a generic greeting and odd signature.

4. The message conveys a sense of urgency by stating "To ensure there is not any service interruption, update immediately!"

5. The message has a call to action of a URL that does not match the title of "Outlook Web Access".
