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Kyoung-Duck Park is an Associate Professor in the Departments of Physics and Semiconductor Engineering at Pohang University of Science and Technology (POSTECH), Korea. He received his Ph.D. in Physics from the University of Colorado Boulder in 2017. His research focuses on tip-enhanced nano-spectroscopy and the nanoscale control of light–matter interactions in low-dimensional quantum materials. His group develops advanced near-field optical techniques to investigate and manipulate excitons, trions, polaritons, and single quantum emitters with nanometer-scale spatial resolution. His research has been recognized with several honors, including the Hyundang Physics Award, the Young Physicist Award of the Korean Physical Society, and a Ministerial Commendation from the Korean Ministry of Science and ICT.
