Nov. 19 from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.

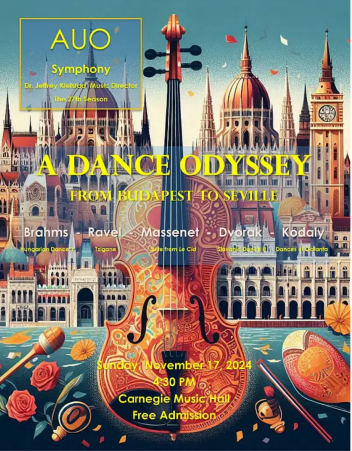
