Jan. 31 from 7:30-10 p.m.

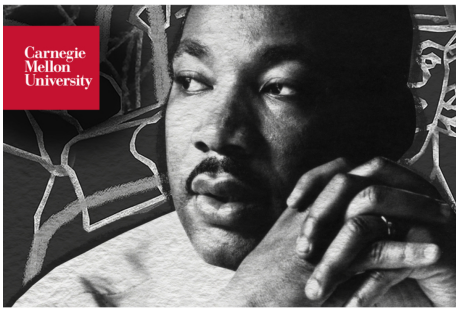
