April 15 from 1 to 5 p.m.

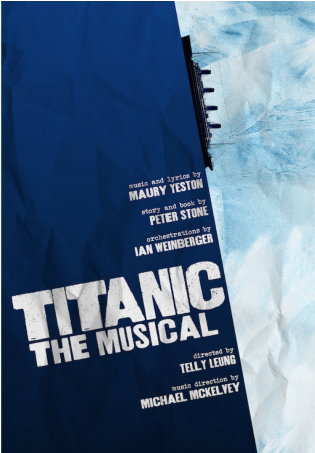
