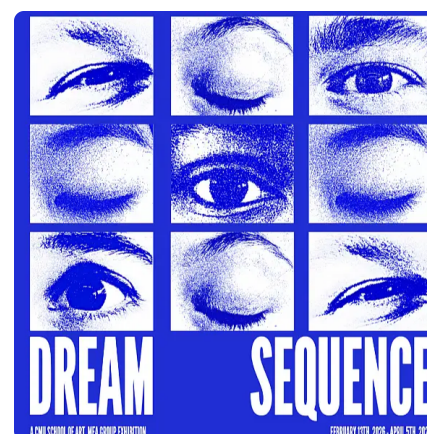

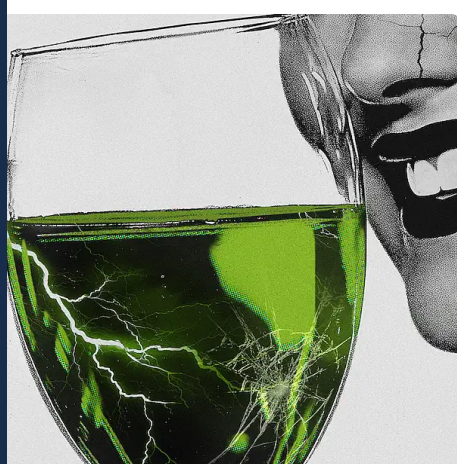
Dream Sequence: School of Art MFA Exhibition
