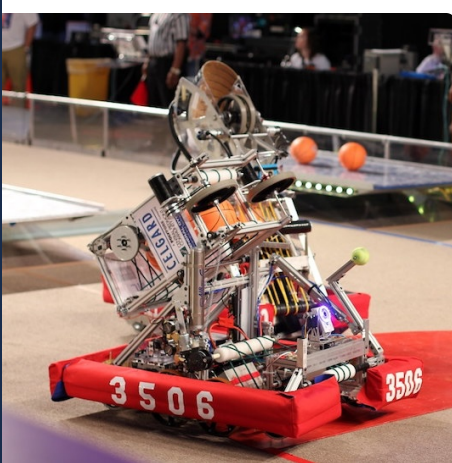
Eraserhead Screening
