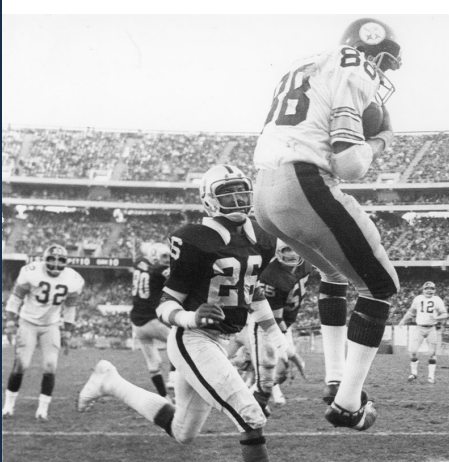
Tropical Rock at The Symphony
