- 1. Are you providing or receiving materials?
- 2. Please describe the precise scientific description of the materials.
- 3. For how long do you or the other party require the materials (months, years, unknown?)
- 4. Are you planning to exchange confidential information in addition to the material?
- 5. Will the material be used with:
 - a. Live vertebrate animals
 - b. Humans
- 6. Will the material contain or involve recombinant DNA including transgenic plants, pathogens, or biological toxins?
- 7. Will the material contain or involve virus, rickettsiae, bacteria, toxin, fungi, mycoplasma, or the genetic elements of such items (chromosomes, genomes, plasmids, transposons, and vectors, whether genetically modified or unmodified)?
- 8. Will the material contain radioactive components?
- 9. Do you anticipate any intellectual property being created or developed as a result of the use of the transferred materials?
- 10. Will the material be imported from or exported to a foreign country?
- 11. Will a foreign national (whether inside the US or outside the US) receive the material?
- 12. Do you know if the material is subject to export control?
- 13. Where will the material be housed?
- 14. Wil the material be used in sponsored research? If yes, please provide sponsored award number.
- 15. Please provide a brief summary of the research and intended use of the material.
- 16. Will you need to modify the material?
- 17. Will the modified material become incorporated into the material?
- 18. Is the material commercially available?

Confidentiality Agreement/Non-Disclosure Agreement questions

- 1. What it the purpose of this exchange (please be specific)
- 2. Is it mandatory to receive or disclose confidential information in order to accomplish the purpose?
- 3. Are you involved in any other agreement with the other party?
- 4. What does the confidential information that you wish to protect pertain to?
- 5. What is the term required for the NDA?
- 6. Are you a U.S Citizen and are others who will require access to the confidential information U.S. Citizens. If not, please provide Citizenship.

- 7. Will you be providing or receiving any biological or chemical materials or software during your discussions with the other party?
- 8. Will you or the company be doing any work at this time (NDAs only cover confidentiality, not work so a different agreement may be needed if the answer is yes)?
- 9. Please summarize the scope of the discussions in a short sentence or sentences that we can add to the NDA.
- 10. Is there any CMU IP involved in the disclosure?
- 11. Does any third party have rights to the information being disclosed by the PI or were third party funds used in developing the information?
- 12. Will any foreign nationals have access to the confidential information being disclosed or received?
- 13. Is any of the information to be received or disclosed export controlled?
- 14. Is the other party a foreign company or have affiliates that will provide or have access the CMU confidential information?
- 15. Are you expecting to be able to use the information provided in your research?
- 16. What formats will the information be provided in?
- 17. Will the information be accessed via a secure secured server?
- 18. If you receive data will you need to retain an archived version?
- 19. Will any non-employees or students require access to the confidential information?
