PARKING PERMITS

Currently all students interested in parking permits will need to complete an application and be added to a waitlist. Applications are available by visiting our office between the hours of 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

ZIPCAR

Faculty/staff and students can join Zipcar. The membership fee to join is \$35 annually. Carnegie Mellon community do not have to pay an application fee. You only need to have a valid driver's license for at least two years. Driver may have no more than two incidents in the past three years. Zipcar does not require parental consent or additional liability coverage for membership.

SHUTTLE/ESCORT

The Shuttle and Escort Services offers transportation options for students, faculty and staff. The shuttle service operates on a fixed route with specific stops. There are also shuttles that service the Pittsburgh Technology Center (PTC) and Bakery Square.
