This crime alert is to inform the CMU community about an incident that may have involved a sexual assault. It is believed the incident occurred between 3 and 3:40 a.m. on Saturday, February 8 at Mudge House, 1000 Morewood Avenue.

CMU Police are investigating the incident to gain more information about what transpired. Anyone with information regarding this matter is asked to call the CMUPD at 412-268-2323. Due to the active investigation we are not able to share more information at this time.

The university has increased CMU Police presence in the area.
